

Tournament Format: Age Divisions: Boys 6 & Under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, Girls 7-9, 10-12 play 3-hole matches. Boys 13-15, 16-18, and Girls 13-18 play 6-hole matches.

**Foursome Matches** – Holes 1-3 or 1-6: Each team plays one ball and the players alternate hitting shots until the ball is holed. *Turn in scorecard at the 4<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> tee and pick up scorecard for Four-Ball Match.* Team captains are to sign card.

**Four-Ball Matches** – Holes 4-6 or 7-12; Each player plays his/her own ball and they use the lowest score made on the hole for the team score. *Turn in scorecard at the 7<sup>th</sup> or 13<sup>th</sup> tee and pick up scorecard for Singles Match.* Team captains are to sign card

**Singles Matches** – Holes 7-9 or 13-18; Each player plays his/her own ball against one other player. *Turn in scorecard at clubhouse and pick food and beverage tickets.* Each player is to sign card.

**Scoring:** The standing of the match is determined “by hole”. The team with the lowest score on a hole is the winner of that hole. The total number of strokes taken for all the three holes has no bearing on the match. A match is over when either team has won more holes than the number of holes left to play.

**Example for Matches:**

- If GCJGF and JGFA have the same score on the 1<sup>st</sup> hole, the hole is “Halved” (TIED).
- If GCJGF has the lowest score on the 1<sup>st</sup> hole, GCJGF will be “1 Up”. If JGFA has the lowest score on the hole, they will be 1 Up.
- If GCJGF wins the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> hole, GCJGF wins the match 2 and 1 and earn one point for the match.
- If GCJGF wins the 1<sup>st</sup> hole and GCJGF and JGFA halve the 2<sup>nd</sup> hole, GCJGF is DORMIE (they cannot lose the match) going into the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole.
- If GCJGF wins the 1<sup>st</sup> hole, JGFA wins the 2<sup>nd</sup> hole, and they tie the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole, the match is “Halved” and both teams earn 1/2 of a point.

The most a team can win is by 2 for a three-hole match (if either GCJGF or JGFA wins the first 2 holes with 1 hole to play the match ends at 2 & 1 (2 up with 1 to play). The match is over after 2 holes because the team that is 2 down cannot win as there is only one hole is left to play.

Possible Match Results:

Halved (GCJGF & JGFA tied on all 3 holes)

1 Up (GCJGF or JGFA won only one hole and the others two were tied)

2 Up (the 1<sup>st</sup> hole was tied and either GCJGF or JGFA won the next 2 holes or either GCJGF or JGFA won holes 1 & 3)

2 & 1 (either GCJGF or JGFA won the first 2 holes)

The most a team can win by is 4 for a six-hole match (if either GCJGF or JGFA wins the first 4 holes with 2 holes to play the match ends at 4 & 2 (4 up with 2 to play). The match is over after 4 holes because the team that is 4 down cannot win when there are only two holes left to play.
